## 2023 JUNIOR FAIR REPTILES RULES

- 1. Exhibitors can enter and show ALL their reptiles according to breed and appearances of their tank/cages.
- 2. All places will receive ribbons.
- 3. Member must follow all rules for exhibiting reptiles at the fair.
- 4. Make sure all tank tops can be secured. Secure latches should be on all doors. If you want to lock the cage, make sure someone is available with a key, in case of emergency.
- 5. Space may be limited. If it is possible, please display reptiles in smaller tanks for fair. You are allowed any number of reptiles in one tank, but the exhibitor is only judged on one.
- 6. Please make sure reptiles are healthy and have no sign of ticks or mites.
- 7. If your reptile is sick or dies before fair, you can still be judged, because all judging for the reptile project is based on knowledge. However, you will lose points on the condition of the cage. You must notify the Junior Fair Reptile Coordinator if you reptile is unable to be brought to fair because of poor health.

## **Interview judging:**

Exhibitors will be judged upon their knowledge of their reptile and the completion of the Reptile Show Supplement Questions.

Exhibitors must know the 4-H pledge.

A poster on any one of the exhibitor's reptiles will be counted as points for this judging. This poster should include basic information about the reptile.
