- Market steer tagging day: Sunday, December 3, 2023 at the Trumbull County Fairgrounds. Market registration forms are due at this time.
- □ Enroll in 4-H by **Monday**, **April 1**, **2024** (online enrollment for existing families [https://4honline.com], paper enrollment for new). This also includes parent/guardian expectations form. \*\*Make sure the proper projects are enrolled for the new year. For carcass participants, you must select: COP-Animal: 113.23 Carcass Steer (towards the bottom of project drop down list) under project selection on online enrollment.
- Select a project book(s) to complete:
  - 117 Beef Project & Record Book (includes 117M Market Beef, 117B Beef Breeding, 117BF Beef Feeder) (\$8)
  - o 117R Beef Resource Handbook (\$17.75)
- □ **Beef Feeder & Heifer Projects** must turn in an animal registration by **April 1**<sup>st</sup> to the OSUE Trumbull Office. The original forms will be given to the advisor for tag-in in late April.
- □ Read over and understand 2024 Trumbull County Beef Rules & club rules. County rules can be found at <a href="www.trumbull.osu.edu">www.trumbull.osu.edu</a> >> 4-H Youth Development >> Trumbull County Jr. Fair Forms: Rules & Registrations.
- □ Attend Quality Assurance (QA). Two options offered in 2024. In-Person QA: Saturday, April 13, 2024 from 9:00 am 11:00 am at the Trumbull County Fairgrounds. If a youth member is younger than 16 years of age, a parent or guardian must attend the quality assurance program with them. Test-Out Option- Thursday, April 11, 2024 from 4:00-5:30 pm at the OSUE Office. (Ages 12 and up). You must RSVP. You may attend another county's QA or a state accredited program. Must provide proof of attendance. Quality Assurance must be complete 45 days prior to the start of fair (by Friday, May 24, 2024).
- □ **Beef feeder tagging day**: **Saturday, April 27, 2024** from 10:00 am-12:00 pm at the Trumbull County Fairgrounds.
- □ Attend Livestock Project Judging on **Tuesday**, **June 4**<sup>th</sup>, **2024 from 6:00-8:00 pm** at the Trumbull County Fairgrounds. This is a requirement for project completion and eligibility for jr. fair participation.

### **Special Notes:**

Drug Use Notification Forms (DUNF) will be completed electronically in 2024. DUNF forms
help document any antibiotics and/or other medication administered to a market animal prior
to fair. All withholding times must elapse prior to entering fair.

# **Project Information:**

• Members <u>must</u> complete project judging/skillathon for their respective project in order to exhibit at the fair and receive credit for the 4-H year.

### Fair Information:

- Fair passes for members in good standing will be given to club advisor prior to the start of fair for distribution. You must turn in your ticket for a wristband at the Junior Fair Board Office.
- The wristband is your admission pass for fair entry/exit throughout week.

- Beef projects must arrive at the Trumbull County Fair by the following times: Weigh In: Carcass Steers- Sunday, July 7 at 5:00 pm. Live Steers- Monday, July 8 at 7:00 pm. Feeders & Heifers- Monday, July 8th by 11:59 pm.
- Beef Showmanship: Thursday, July 11, 2024 at 11:00 am in sale barn.
- Market Steer & Beef Feeder Show: Thursday, July 11, 2024 at 6:00 pm in sale barn.
- Livestock Sale: Saturday, July 13, 2024 beginning at 10:30 am in sale barn.
