 - Each clothing project must have its own total look outfit. Participants are to wear outfit while being judged. Garment will be left at the OSUE Office until the Fashion Revue.
 - Fill out Fashion Revue Narration Form prior to attending Clothing Project Judging. Assistance will be available if needed with narration form.
 - o Items will be left at the OSUE Office until the Fashion Revue evening. Please store items in plastic/garment bag and keep associated number with item.

o Items will be transferred to the block building prior to the Fashion Revue by a Family Consumer Science Committee member (Approximately 4:30 pm).

Special Notes:

 Please notify the OSUE-Trumbull Office (by phone or email Ashlee at <u>Meardith.1@osu.edu</u>) of *dropped projects* prior to Clothing Project Judging. This is imperative for the number of judges we have present.

Project Information:

Members <u>must</u> complete clothing project judging on **July 5**, **2024** for their respective project in order to receive place ribbons at the Trumbull County Fair and be eligible to compete at the Ohio State Fair.

Fair Information:

- Fair passes for members in good standing will be given to club advisor prior to the start of fair for distribution. You must turn in your ticket for a wristband at the Fair Board Office. The wristband is your admission pass for fair entry/exit throughout week.
- Fashion Review (modeling of project & awards) will be held Monday, July 8, 2024 at 5:30 p.m. at the Historical Stage (weather permitting). Please arrive no later than 5:00 pm to receive your garment/item and dress for the Fashion Review.
- State Fair Representative (Delegate & Alternate) Recognition will follow the Fashion Review & Royal Court Ceremony at approximately 7:15 pm at the Historical Stage.
- All projects will have the opportunity to be displayed in the 4-H Block Building. If your club
 does not have a booth to display clothing project. Please alert advisor or 4-H educator at
 Clothing Project Judging.
