Cloverbud Booth Display Item

- Each Cloverbud is invited to submit an item to display in the county-wide Cloverbud Booth, which is in the 4-H Block Building. The display item should be something created by the Cloverbud during a 4-H meeting, activity, or event, or as a representation of something they learned during their time as a Cloverbud.
- Items should be dropped off to Kelly Beers in the 4-H Block Building on **Sunday, July 6** between 1:00pm and 4:00pm **or on Monday, July 7** between 9:00am and 12:00noon. (Advisors may also collect items from Cloverbuds and turn them in on the Cloverbuds' behalf.)

Cloverbud 4-H Poster Display

- Each Cloverbud member may enter one (1) poster that reflects something they have learned related to the 4-H program in Trumbull County. This may include animal-related topics or other topics.
- Posters should be 22" x 28" and should be displayed horizontally. Posters may not have any 3-D elements (anything that sticks out from the poster).
- Posters should be labeled in the bottom right-hand corner with the Cloverbud's name, 4-H age (age as of January 1), animal species, and 4-H club name.
- Posters can be turned into an advisor from the Silver Claws 4-H Club, on **Tuesday, July 8** between 10:00am and 4:00pm in the Rabbit/Cat/Sale Barn. (Advisors may also collect posters from Cloverbuds and turn them in on the Cloverbuds' behalf.) Cloverbuds will be recognized for their participation only- this is not a contest. Posters will be displayed in the Cloverbud Booth in the 4-H Block Building throughout the week.

Cloverbud Stuffed Rabbit Display

- **On Sunday, July 6 or Monday, July 7** Cloverbuds may bring a stuffed rabbit to display in a cage in the rabbit barn. Cloverbuds should bring bowls for their rabbit, and may even make a nametag to hang on the cage. Check in with an advisor at the main info table for a cage assignment.

Cloverbud Graduation (NEW FOR 2025)

- **Monday, July 7** following the Royal Court announcements (around 6:45pm): All Cloverbuds who will graduate from the Cloverbud program this year (who will be 8 years old and in third grade this fall) will be recognized on stage.

Cloverbud Lamb Lead Line

- **Tuesday, July 8** at approximately 2:00pm (directly following the Junior Fair Sheep Show) in the Rabbit/Cat/Sale Barn Ring: Cloverbuds can learn how to lead and show a lamb during the Jr. Fair Lamb Show. 4-H members will be on hand in the ring to assist Cloverbuds as needed.

Cloverbud Goat Show

- **Wednesday, July 9** at approximately 2:00pm (directly following the Junior Fair Goat Show) in the Sale Ring in the Rabbit/Cat/Sale Barn: Cloverbuds can register the morning of this event on-site in the sale ring (beginning at 9:00am). Cloverbuds will be able to walk a goat in the sale ring along with the assistance of an older 4-H member.

Cloverbud Show & Tell

- **Wednesday, July 9** at 1:00pm in the 4-H Block Building: Cloverbuds may prepare a brief “Show & Tell” presentation on a topic of their choosing related to their experience as a Cloverbud. The presentation can be completed alone or as part of a team. Presentations may include a poster, a talk, a skit, a demonstration of a skill, showing off something that the Cloverbud made, or something else. Please feel free to get creative! This is a great way for Cloverbuds to prepare for 4-H judging and public speaking opportunities in the future.

Dress-ups may be in one of three categories: Famous pairs (owner and stuffed animal dressed as a pair), fair theme (this year’s theme is “Welcome to the Jungle”), or general (any dress-up they would like).
