

2026 Trumbull County 4-H Clothing & Textile Project Judging

How do I complete clothing project judging this year?

- 4-H members wishing to complete their clothing project in 2026 will be completing in-person project judging on **Friday, June 26th** at the **OSU Extension Office** from **1:00-3:00 pm**.
- Members who are enrolled in more than one clothing project will need to complete judging for each project.
- Members are to bring their project book with them and the required item/garment according to the project completion list. This can be found on our website at: <https://trumbull.osu.edu/program-areas/4-h-youth-development/4-h-project-information>
- Members will complete a one-on-one interview with an adult judge, selected by the 4-H educator and FCS Committee.
- A judging order will be determined in early June and will be communicated via email and mail to participants.
- Members will have the opportunity to change into garments as they need to model their project.
- Members will leave the total look/complete outfit at the OSUE Office once judging is complete. A member of the FCS committee will transport all clothing items to the fairgrounds for the Fashion Revue held on Monday, July 13th at 5:30 pm. It is encouraged for members bring a plastic bag or garment bag to store project items in.

Is there a make-up option for Clothing Project Judging this year?

Similar to 2025 and previous, if members cannot or do not wish to attend in-person judging on June 26th, judging can be completed by an advisor. Advisors must turn in completed score sheets by July 1st to the OSU Extension Office in order for members to receive official completion status and a weekly fair pass. **Members interested in Ohio State Fair participation, must complete project judging on June 26th.**
