**Please read carefully:**

- Members must follow all rules for exhibiting reptiles at the fair.** A copy is located at the Extension Office and in the Junior Fair Book.
- Make sure all tank tops can be secured.** Secure latches should be on all doors. If you want to lock the cage, make sure someone is available with a key, in case of emergency.
- Space may be limited.** If it is possible, please display reptiles in smaller tanks for fair. You are allowed any number of reptiles in one tank, but the exhibitor is only judged on one.
- If space permits and in order to enhance the reptile display, we welcome other reptiles in addition to the project reptiles. If you would like to bring additional reptiles, please contact the Junior Fair Reptile Coordinator (Wanda Sawyer).
- Please make sure reptiles are healthy and have no sign of ticks or mites.** If your reptile is sick or dies before fair, you can still be judged, because all judging for the reptile project is based on knowledge. However, you will lose points on the condition of the cage. You must notify the Junior Fair Reptile Coordinator (Wanda Sawyer) if your reptile is unable to be brought to fair because of poor health.

**I/We understand that I/we must appropriately care for all registered animals during the fair week. Caring for registered animals includes but is not limited to the following items:**

1. Cleaning in, around, and underneath each registered animal=s cage before 10:00 a.m. daily.
2. Cleaning each registered animal=s cage prior to leaving the fairgrounds on the last day of fair.
3. Making sure each registered animal is properly fed and watered throughout the day.
