2023 TRUMBULL CO. 4-H JUNIOR ROYAL COURT GUIDELINES

Applications are due to Trumbull Co OSU Extension Office Saturday, April 1, 2023 by 4:30 p.m.

The Trumbull County 4-H Junior Royal Court is a program for 9-13 year old 4-H members who have completed at least one year in 4-H. The Junior Royal Court is a leadership and community service program where youth represent 4-H throughout the year as the royalty of Trumbull County.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The 4-H Junior Royal Court is made up of a 4-H Jr. Prince, 4-H Jr. Princess, and a court consisting of 4 girls and 4 boys.
- 2. Contestants must **actively** participate in the 2023 Trumbull County Fair (July 10-16, 2023).
- 3. The 4-H Junior Royal Court are required to make daily and nightly appearances at judging events and exhibit areas, wearing the proper attire (sashes & proper dress). If for any reason a contestant cannot accept this responsibility, he/she should not compete.
- 4. The 4-H Junior Royal Court representatives should maintain the dress and poise of their position during the entire time of the Trumbull County Fair and throughout the year while acting as a Trumbull County 4-H Junior Royal Court member.
- 5. The 4-H Junior Royal Court may be asked to make appearances at various 4-H and non 4-H sponsored events throughout the next year as a 4-H representative or spokesperson. Opportunities where 4-H Junior Royal Court members will be requested are: Neighboring county fairs, community parades/festivals, 4-H Proclamation Day (Mar), Trumbull County 4-H Kickoff (Nov) Ohio 4-H week (Mar), project judging (June), and others as they arise.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. For youth ages 9-13 years old (as of Jan. 1) who have completed at least one year of 4-H
- 2. Must be a current member of a 4-H club in Trumbull County.
- 3. Youth interested in participating in the 4-H Junior Royal Court contest must submit the following to the Trumbull County OSU Extension Office by **Saturday, April 1, 2023 by 4:30 p.m.:**
 - a. Trumbull County 4-H Junior Royal Court Application (handwritten)
 - b. Royal Court Fact Sheet
 - c. Trumbull County 4-H Junior Royal Court Guidelines SIGNED
 - d. Large recent photograph (preferably a head/shoulder shot), 8"x10" photo is preferred. Your photograph will be displayed in the 4-H Royal Court booth at the Trumbull County Fair; photo will be returned to you after the fair.

JUDGING INFORMATION

- 1. 4-H Junior Royal Court applications will be judged by three outside judges. Applications represent 210 points of your total score (each judge can award up to 70 points).
- 2. All applicants for the 4-H Junior Royal Court will be interviewed by three judges. Interview date TBD; Social distancing will be observed as well as any other health guidelines provided by Ohio 4-H or county health department. Interviews will account for 210 of your total points (each interview judge can award up to 70 points). Each applicant will receive a letter in April with his/her scheduled interview time.
- 3. Applicants must complete and submit their application by April 1 <u>and</u> complete the interview on selected date. Make-up interviews will not be permitted.
- 4. Interviews will be based on: 4-H activities (participation, leadership, achievements, and initiative), 4-H project participation, general 4-H knowledge, and personal appearance.
- 5. Suggested attire for interviews: girls should wear nice dresses or skirts/blouses; boys should wear a pants and a button-up shirt.
- 6. If only one applicant applies for a title, a minimum score will be set by the Royal Court Committee instead of the applicant joining 4-H Royal Court on default.
- 7. The 4-H Junior Royal Prince, Princess, and court will be announced during the Royal Court ceremonies at the 2023 Trumbull County Fair. All contestants (male and female) have the opportunity to bring an escort to the ceremony. Escorts need to be identified when application is submitted.
- 8. Participants should wear dress attire for the 4-H Royal Court ceremony on Monday during the Trumbull County Fair.
- 9. Applications **MUST** be completed by the applicant, **NOT** the parent.

AWARDS

- 1. 4-H Junior Royal Court Prince will receive a sash and crown.
- 2. 4-H Junior Royal Court Princess will receive a sash, tiara, and flowers.
- 3. 4-H Junior Royal Court members will receive a sash and small flowers.

SCORING BREAKDOWN

- 1. Applications a total of 210 points (70 points from each judge)
- 2. Interviews a total of 210 points (70 points from each judge)
- 3. Total possible points: 420
