TRUMBULL JUNIOR FAIR ANIMAL POSTER CONTEST RULES

- 1. Each poster must be made by a 4-H member enrolled in an animal project. Registrations forms must be returned to the Extension Office no later than July 1st in order to participate in this event.
- 2. Members taking more than one animal species may enter more than one poster. However, if display space is limited, members may be asked to choose one poster to enter/display at the fair.
- 3. Posters must be turned in to Poster Contest Chairperson (any 4-H Silver Claws Club Advisor) any time between 10am and 4pm on Tuesday of Fair Week. Silver Claws Advisors can be located in the Small Animal Barn. Advisors are: Barb Ames, Melody Lynn, Marie Moore.
- 4. Posters must be made on 22"x28" poster board, displayed horizontally. Posters should not be mounted on any type of stiff backing.
- 5. It is recommended that all posters be covered tightly with a thin, plastic covering or laminated in order to protect it during fair week.
- 6. No 3-D posters will be accepted.
- 7. Each poster must be clearly labeled in the lower, right hand corner, in a space on larger than 3"x5" with member name, age as of January 1st, small animal species, and club.
- 8. Posters should reflect an educational / informational aspect of the animal specie.
- 9. Posters will be judged on neatness/appearance, educational/informational content, and originality/creativity.
- 10. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place Ribbons will be awarded for each species.
