

Trumbull County 4-H Advisory Committee Mini-Grant Application

Does your 4-H club need additional funds to purchase educational materials, take an educational field trip, promote 4-H, complete a community service project or recruit new members? This is your opportunity to apply for matching funds from the Trumbull County 4-H Advisory Committee.

PURPOSE

All 4-H Club members and volunteers are expected to instill in their members a sense of individual pride through educational achievement and community service. Therefore, the committee has allocated money to award 4-H clubs to help them in furthering their efforts in education, recruitment and community service projects.

GUIDELINES

- Mini grants are available for projects that strength the educational experience of the county's 4-H youth and adult volunteers.
 - Application must be completed in its entirety to be considered.
 - Application must include the signature of the club advisor and the 4-H club president.
 - Applicants must provide matching dollars in order to be eligible. Any club requesting over \$100.00 must submit a detailed budget.
 - Grants are not to be used for purchasing awards, parade materials, booth decorations, project books, project supplies or items that would be used in 4-H or junior fair competition.
 - Members of the Trumbull County 4-H Advisory Committee will evaluate applications. Decisions of the evaluation committee are final.
 - Award recipients are required to present a report/presentation of the completed project at a Trumbull County 4-H Advisory Committee meeting on how the funds were used and the knowledge gained from the project.
- **DEADLINE**
 - Completed mini grant application will be due January 1, April 1, July, 1 or September 1. Mini grants must be sent to the OSU Extension Office at 520 W. Main St., Suite 1, Cortland, OH 44410.
